

Addenda: Supplementary Annexes to the BTC Pipeline Resettlement Action Plan Part D Turkey

As foreshadowed by the BTC Pipeline Resettlement Action Plan Part D (November 2002), disclosed within Turkey commencing December 2002, some additional consultations and expert investigations have subsequently been conducted in the following areas:

- Refining compensation measures for fishermen whose activities will be affected by operation of the Ceyhan Marine Terminal
- Designing a methodology for allocation and deployment of 'RAP Funds'
- Clarifying certain procedures for the acquisition of private land.

Findings from these supplementary studies have been incorporated in four new addenda that did not appear in the November 2002 BTC Pipeline Resettlement Action Plan Part D. The new addenda are listed in the table below. Two of the addenda provide information that supersedes measures described in the body of the BTC RAP Part D (see table below).
