1.	Purpose of Meeting
1.1.	Anton Knoetze (AK) of The Biovac Institute (Pty) Ltd (Biovac) opened the meeting and welcomed all attendees, after which individual introductions were made. A full list of attendees is provided above. The purpose of the meeting was to provide a progress update on the proposed Vaccine Manufacturing Production Facility, including the current site status, security measures, construction timelines, and funding progress, as well as to engage with community stakeholders on key concerns and potential opportunities. A high level summary of the discussion is presented below.
2.	Discussion
2.1.	Overall sentiment among attendees was positive and engaged, with clear interest expressed in both the scale of the proposed development and its anticipated long-term benefits.

	- Attendees demonstrated particular curiosity regarding construction timelines and the visibility of progress on site. - Community members noted and welcomed the security measures already implemented, with specific appreciation for the integration of CCTV systems. - There was expressed interest in exploring opportunities for closer collaboration between Biovac and existing local safety and security structures.
2.2.	Key Concerns - Potential noise impacts associated with construction activities were identified as a concern. - Possible air quality impacts, including dust generation and construction-related emissions, were noted. - Concerns were raised regarding potential effects on local biodiversity and the surrounding environment.
2.3.	Biovac response - It was noted that Environmental Impact Assessments are currently underway, with a commitment to share the findings with the community once finalised. - Biovac provided reassurance that appropriate mitigation measures would be incorporated into construction management plans to address identified impacts. - Biovac further indicated that a simplified grievance and contact mechanism would be shared with the community, enabling concerns related to noise, dust, safety, or other issues to be raised easily and addressed in a timely manner.

AK closed the meeting and thanked everyone for their attendance.
